Women in the Church – 1 Timothy 2

❖ Appearance (Verse 9)

- “I want” or “I will” (verses 8 & 9): Commands from the Lord
- “Adorn”: “to arrange”, “to put in order”
- “Modest” or “proper”: “well ordered”, “well arranged”
- “Apparel” or “clothing”: Not only clothing; “demeanor”, “attitude”

❖ Attitude (Verse 9)

- “Fear”, “proprietary”, “modestly”: modesty mixed with humility
 - Connotes a reserve attitude, shrinking from doing what is dishonorable
- “Sobriety”, “moderation”, “discreetly”: implies self control
 - Controlling ones passions or desires
